#### **Directions**

**From the North:** New Jersey Turnpike South to Exit 9 - After toll plaza, bear left onto Route 18 South - Continue on Route 18 2.5 miles to Cranbury Road (Cranbury) exit - follow Cranbury Road (Route 535) 2.8 miles (bear left at second traffic light) to Fern Road - Turn left onto Fern Road - Continue 1/2 mile to Temple (on right).

**From the South:** New Jersey Turnpike North to Exit 8A - After toll plaza, bear right onto the access road - Right turn at first traffic light onto Cranbury Road (Route 535) - Continue on Cranbury Road for approx. 5 miles to traffic light at Fern Road - Turn right turn onto Fern Road - Continue 1/2 mile to Temple (on right).
